**Scholls Grange Hall** is in need of significant repairs. We have addressed roof, foundation, some structural, drainage, and septic issues. Project estimates to repair structural issues, insulate, replace siding and windows and paint are about \$100,000. A community member has generously donated siding material. We are approaching this work in phases based on urgency and funding available and have recently completed work on the south wall. We rely on fundraising, grants and donations to make improvements.
